SUBJECT: Declaration of conformity according to CE Regulation 1907/2006 REACH, CANDIDATE LIST updated to 17th FEBRUARY 2026; restricted substances Art. 67 Annex XVII

REACH Regulation defines the following:

- **SUBSTANCE:** a chemical element and its compounds in the natural state or obtained by any manufacturing process;
- **PREPARATION:** a mixture or solution composed of two or more substances;
- **ARTICLE:** an object which during production is given a special shape, surface or design which determines its function to a greater degree than does its chemical composition.

According to the same Regulation, manufacturers and/or importers of substances are required to submit a registration dossier to the relevant European Agency.

Producers and/or importers of preparations are required to comply with specific obligations in the event that the "substances" have not been previously registered.

Producers and/or importers of "articles" are subject to the registration obligation only if a substance contained in them is intended to be released under normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use.

FA.BE.RO. SRL does not in any case constitute itself as a producer or importer of substances and/or preparations pursuant to REACH, but only as a producer of articles (washers, plates and Belleville washers) which are not intended, in their raw state, to release substances, under normal conditions of use, and, therefore, is not subject to any registration obligation.

The survey carried out with all our raw material suppliers to verify their position with respect to the REACH regulation has allowed us to verify that all the most important suppliers have already certified that they are REACH approved.

Regarding the presence of dangerous substances (SVHC) in the list updated by ECHA on 4th February 2026, our suppliers state that, according to the production cycles of the raw material, the substances reported in the list (in a concentration higher than the threshold limit established by the Regulation) are not intentionally used or added. The absence, however, has not been verified by tests.

Therefore, based on the information in our possession, there is no obligation to notify the SCIP Database for the products supplied by us.
